



Lichfield Green Conversations, Wednesday 29th November, Guildhall

Supported by Lichfield Re:Cycle and Lichfield City Council

Over 2.5 hours, 45 attendees from 25 groups and organisations took part in 4 facilitated conversations, based around communication, training, an overview of the Green Network, and a mapping exercise. The key points are summarised in this report, along with links to existing resources and organisations which were either highlighted by attendees, or are in response to some of the comments made in the conversations.

Communication

The Green Network can help by:

- Promoting the work of existing organisations, events, resources and information from a central location
- Utilise different communication methods for inclusivity– online, printed, face to face, social media
- Take advantage of existing publications, council newsletters, parish newsletters

Green Network overview

The Green Network could:

- Organise networking events (mix of daytime, evening, weekday, weekend to reach different audiences)
 - Face to face for networking, online for training and wider reach. Share key points of meetings
- Create working groups to share best practise, share outcomes of groups
- Collect data and evidence be able to add to district wide reports, eg # of items saved from landfill, # of trees planted, #of ha managed for wildlife.
- Bid for funding for training for groups
- Share advice and resources, and help to find sources of expertise
- Share information about other initiatives across Staffordshire – eg Climate Commission, Sustainability Board, county council work, sben.

Training/skills

The Green Network could:

- Provide a variety of workshops/training – eg how to target younger people, funding advice, community energy, green policy, renewable energy, nature based solutions
- Support resource and skill sharing between community groups



Existing resources:

During the discussions, it was clear that some information and resources were being asked for which are already in existence, such as advice and support for funding and recruiting volunteers, directories of community groups, and resources on sustainability. It is important that the Green Network does not duplicate information, or try to reinvent the wheel, so existing resources which address some of the comments are listed here.
